

# Organisational

#### National level

- Greece does not have a RE&RI National Committee or a National Code of Conduct for Research
- Only National
   Organization for
   Medicines has a legal mandate

#### Institutes

- RE&RI committees and their Codes of Conduct mainly focus in medical and biomedical research
- There is not a specific procedure for ethical assessment of research projects

## Wider context



#### Awareness

- RE&RI issues have not attracted the attention of the Academia in the extent it has happened in other European countries
- Public awareness needs to be boosted



#### Systemic

 There are inherent difficulties to apply the self regulating principle



- General public Publications in wide circulation newspapers


